Dragon Boat Racing and the Challenge

Dragon Boat Racing is an ancient Chinese tradition and the fastest growing water activity in Britain today - as well as the most fun! Up to 11 people will paddle each 30' boat with a drummer up front beating time and a helm at the tail steering a straight course. No previous experience is required, just plenty of team spirit!

We are delighted to be hosting The Bath Dragon Boat Race for a second year after the fantastic success of the event in 2017. We will again be partnering with Gable Events to this year raise money in support of two Bath based charities – Mountain Way and Designability's Wizzybug Loan Scheme. The event is open to everyone and the crews will battle it out over the 200m course, watched by crowds of spectators.

Entry includes:

- Dragon boats, qualified helms and all racing equipment
- At least three races per crew
- Trophy for the winning crew and medals for the top three crews

Entry details

Crews

Crews must comprise of 8-10 paddlers plus a drummer - squads may be larger. Crews can be mixed, all female or all male and you are able to enter more than one crew. After all, doesn't everyone like a bit of friendly competition? You must be 16 or over to take part but no previous experience of dragon boat racing is required.

Qualified helms, buoyancy aids and water safety cover are provided by the organisers.

Entry Donation

The entry donation per dragon boat is £500. Crews may have less than 11 people but there are no reductions for crews of less than 11.

Charity Sponsorship

Once you have paid your entry donation, we ask that each crew / individual tries to raise as much money as possible with £600 as a minimum whole crew requirement. Official sponsor forms will be supplied with your entry confirmation and all forms and money must be handed in to Race Control before your crew's first race of the day.

What you'll be raising money for

All the funds you raise will help to fund Mountain Way which helps military veterans suffering from Post Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD).
